The purpose of this document is to define the requirements for preparing an ethical claim of responsibility for sustainable growth of a product, a service, a process or an organization. The process of developing an ethical claim of responsibility for sustainable development includes the three dimensions of sustainability, which are:

- economic
- social
- environmental.

An ethical claim of responsibility for sustainable development makes it possible to promote the demand and supply of those products, services, processes or organizations, whose characteristics can stimulate a process of continuous improvement towards sustainability with the involvement of stakeholders according to the principle of materiality.










Independent and continuous verification









Remedies to fake claims on sustainability

1) Standards framework

ISO 17029, ISO 17033 and UNI/Pdr 102

- 2) real presence of the three elements of sustainability: social, economy and environment
- 3) Materiality analysis and listening to interested parties and transaparency of the programme
- 4) independent and competent verification, carried out by a body controlled by an accreditation body designated by the state
